

PSGW Health and Safety Considerations for 2023

We are taking precautions for everyone's safety, even as we are aware that COVID is with us for the foreseeable future. We do have some guidelines for all of us to follow while at camp. These guidelines may change at any time, and if they do, new guidelines will be posted here and on the main PSGW website. For now, we ask that:

Everyone who comes to camp:

- must be fully vaccinated against COVID according to the CDC definition of two doses of the COVID vaccine, completed at least fourteen days before arriving at camp.
- must have received a COVID vaccine booster (third or fourth shot) if eligible. Boosters reduce the risk of infection and prevent severe disease in older and more vulnerable individuals. If you have a documented medical contraindication to receiving a booster, please request an exemption, and we will contact you with details of the exemption criteria and process. We will review and consider all exemption requests in light of the most current CDC guidelines.
- must provide proof of vaccination and boosters. (vaccination card or record on phone).
- is requested to take a home COVID test on the morning they depart for camp.
- must sign a waiver upon arrival agreeing to hold harmless PSGW Board members and contractors should you contract COVID while at camp.
- agrees that if they come down with symptoms at camp, they will need to take another test. PSGW will provide the test. If the results are positive, they will need to leave the site and we will prorate a refund.
- agrees that camp, like any gathering, poses health risks. We will do our best to keep everyone safe!
